## International Contest Prize "Marzio Rosi" Sixth edition Composition for Ensemble of Percussion Instrument

**Duration:** the duration of the composition must be a maximum of 8 minutes

Age limit: there is no age limit

**Deadline**: February 28th 2020 **Art. 1 – Competition Notice** 

The Conservatorio di musica "L. Perosi" of Campobasso announces the Sixth International "Marzio Rosi"

competition.

The competition, named for a composition for Percussion Ensemble, is open to composers of all nationalities, with no age limit, by sending one or more compositions.

If there is more than one submission, a registration fee must be paid for each score according to the indications specified in Article 5: <u>Sending scores</u>

The competition will award the prize to a composition for Percussion Ensemble which is unpublished-and has been never performed in public or awarded in other competitions, for a maximum duration of 8 minutes.

#### **INSTRUMENTATION**

This competition requires 6 musicians, with or without a conductor Instruments that may be used: 2 five octave marimbas, 1 vibraphone, 1 xylophone, 1 glockenspiel, 5 timpani, 1 bass drum, 2 snare drum, 4 tom toms, 1 Tam Tam (diameter:  $\emptyset = 80$  cm), 1 suspended cymbal, clash cymbals, 1 tambourine, a pair of bongos, 1 conga, a pedal bass drum. It is the candidate's choice to use the requested instruments in part or in whole

However, the number of artists must be 6 percussionists.

#### Art. 2 - Competition Calendar

February 28th 2020: deadline for the submission of the application and the delivery of the work in competition.

The competition will be divided into two phases: selection phase and final phase.

In the selection phase the Jury, based on the evaluation of the scores received (it is possible, at the candidate's option, to send a demonstration audio file of the composition), will select three compositions that will be admitted to the final phase of the Competition;

the three finalist works will be performed in a public concert, in the presence of the jury of the Award "Marzio Rosi" competition, performed by the Percussion Ensemble of the "Perosi" Conservatory of Campobasso, during the second evening of the XI edition of 2020 Festival percussion i, which will be held on 10 May 2020.

At the end of the concert the Jury will proceed to determine the winner of the competition. The award ceremony will take place during the final evening of the XI edition of the 2020 Festivalpercussioni, which will be held on 10 May 2020.

#### Art. 3 - Jury

The Jury will retain the right not to award the International Prize "Marzio Rosi" The judgment of the Jury is final and cannot be appealed.

#### Art. 4 - Prize

The composer that will be win the "Marzio Rosi" award will receive a prize of € 1,500.00 EUROS (one thousand five hundred/00 EUROS) gross, subject to a withholding tax of Irpef as established by law.

#### Art. 5 - Sending scores

Each score, submitted in .pdf format, must include:

the title of the composition, the instrumentation and the duration of the composition; also it must include the name and surname, the date, the place of birth , and the nationality of the competitor.

The scores must be sent by e-mail by midnight of February 28th 2020 to the following e-mail address: premiomarziorosi@conservatorioperosi.it

The email must also contain:

- 1) the completed registration form;
- 2) the receipt of the registration fee;
- 3) a declaration that the composition is unpublished and has never been performed in public or awarded in other competitions;
- 4) a signed waiver for an eventual performance within the Festival percussioni;
- 5) a declaration of a full and unconditional acceptance of all the conditions of the competition.
- 6) a signed personal privacy agreemnt to the law.

#### Art. 6 - Application fee payement

There is a registration fee is € 30.00 for each composition submitted and this fee must be paid to the bank account of the "Lorenzo Perosi" Conservatory of Music in Campobasso, IBAN n. IT47 B076 0103 8000 0001 2856 860
